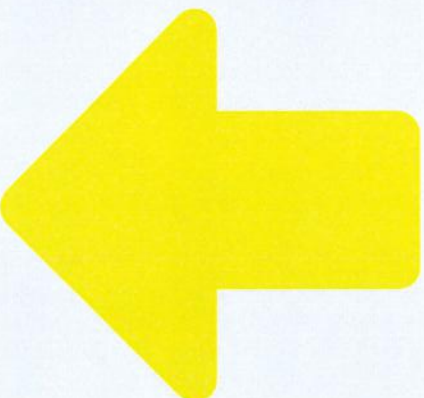
We opened in 2000, as a partnership between the Grande Prairie Friendship Centre & the Grande Prairie Regional College.
